<b>Conditions and Procedures of Issuing the Permit</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To issue the permit, the applicant shall obtain the initial approval of the licensing authority in the Emirate, in accordance with the legislation in force in this regard.</li> <li>The owner of the establishment, or his legal representative, submits the permit application prepared by the RTA through its approved service delivery channels, accompanied by the following documents: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The initial approval to conduct the activity issued by the licensing authority in the Emirate for new establishments, and a copy of the commercial license for existing establishments.</li> <li>The approval of the competent authority to carry out the activity if the legislation in force requires obtaining such approval.</li> <li>A copy of the valid passport or identity card of the establishment's owner and all partners, in addition to a copy of the valid residency voucher for the non-citizen partner.</li> <li>An undertaking to abide by the conditions and requirements necessary to carry out the activity.</li> </ol> </li> </ol>																		
<b>Licensing Conditions and Entity's Obligations</b>	<p><b>Conditions for issuing a permit to the recreational motorcycle rental office:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Obtain initial approval from the Licensing Agency to engage in recreational motorcycle rental activities.</li> <li>Open one traffic file for all the recreational motorcycles belonging to the rental office.</li> <li>Provide no less than twenty (20) recreational motorcycles intended for each age group, according to the classification provided in the table below:</li> </ol> <table border="1"> <thead> <tr> <th>#</th> <th>Age of recreational motorcycle rider</th> <th>Engine capacity</th> <th>Max speed of recreational motorcycle</th> </tr> </thead> <tbody> <tr> <td>1</td> <td>More than (5) years and less than (8) years</td> <td>(50 cc) or less</td> <td>Less than 25 km/h.</td> </tr> <tr> <td>2</td> <td>From (8) years to (16) years</td> <td>More than (50 cc) and less than (90 cc)</td> <td>From 25-80 km/h</td> </tr> <tr> <td>3</td> <td>More than (16) years</td> <td>(90 cc) or above</td> <td>More than 80 km/h</td> </tr> </tbody> </table> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>When they are first registered, the recreational motorcycles' life shall not be more than six (6) years old, and shall pass the technical examination conducted by the Agency.</li> <li>Comply with the conditions and requirements necessary to engage in recreational motorcycle rental activity.</li> </ol> <p><b>Recreational motorcycle rental office obligations:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Prepare a special record containing the names, nationalities and ages of the tenants of recreational motorcycles, the date and time of the rental, its duration, and any other information to be noted as required by the Agency.</li> </ol>			#	Age of recreational motorcycle rider	Engine capacity	Max speed of recreational motorcycle	1	More than (5) years and less than (8) years	(50 cc) or less	Less than 25 km/h.	2	From (8) years to (16) years	More than (50 cc) and less than (90 cc)	From 25-80 km/h	3	More than (16) years	(90 cc) or above	More than 80 km/h

2. Maintain a copy of the recreational motorcycle license and ownership documents, and any other documents specified by the Agency, and present them on request.
3. Provide renters of recreational motorcycles with an introductory guide that includes public safety measures before driving.
4. The times set by the establishment to rent and drive a recreational motorcycle.
5. The conditions approved by the concerned bodies in the Emirate for storing recreational motorcycle fuel.
6. Not to rent a recreational motorcycle to any person who is not in good health, or who is under the age of sixteen (16) Gregorian years, except under the approval of his guardian and under his supervision
7. Not to rent any recreational motorcycle belonging to third parties unless after obtaining the prior approval of the Agency.
8. Comply with health and environment requirements when performing maintenance for recreational motorcycles.
9. Prepare a guide board that includes the price list for renting recreational motorcycles along with all their age groups.
10. Not to rent a recreational motorcycle that is not registered or whose license has expired.
11. Verify that the renter of a recreational motorcycle meets the requirements for driving the recreational motorcycle; namely:
  - His age is not be less than (16) calendar years, and those under this age may drive it under the supervision and responsibility of their guardians, provided that the recreational motorcycle is suitable for the use of this group.
  - He is fit to drive a recreational motorcycle.
  - He is familiar with the rules for operating and driving a recreational motorcycle.
  - He wears clothing intended for riding a recreational motorcycle, including a bumper-helmet.
  - He complies with safety and security requirements.
  - He does not make any changes to the recreational motorcycle, in a manner that results in exceeding the speed prescribed for it, or the issuance of noise or fuss during its operation or driving.
12. Not to rent any recreational motorcycle that does not meet the general safety and security requirements set by the Agency.
13. Provide parking spaces for recreational motorcycles, and obtain the necessary approvals for that from the concerned bodies in the Emirate.
14. Not to use and rent a recreational motorcycle for more than six (6) years from the date of manufacture, provided that it has passed the technical examination.
15. Prepare a recreational motorcycle usage manual and obtain the Agency's approval therefor.
16. Not to register, use or rent a (regular) motorbike in the recreational motorcycle rental activity.
17. Notify the Agency about the intention to cease business temporarily 60 days in advance, and submit the application to cease business 30 days in advance of the set date, provided that the suspension of business shall not exceed one year, which is renewable subject to the approval of the Agency.
18. The recreational motorcycle shall be suitable for use, and its validity shall be proven upon request on the basis of a technical examination report issued by the Agency.
19. The recreational motorcycle and its passengers shall be insured under a comprehensive and valid insurance policy issued by an insurance company against accidents and civil liability.
20. The recreational motorcycle shall be owned by the rental office, and this ownership will be proven upon request according to the official documents.
